### **Manner of Execution of such projects/programmes**

The Company shall execute the aforementioned projects directly or through any entity, company, public trust, or society as specified in the Rule 4 of the Companies (Corporate Social Responsibility Policy) Rules, 2014, including any re-enactments, modifications, or amendments thereto.

### **Modalities of fund utilization & Implementation schedule:**

- The entire budgeted amount for the FY 2026-27 (not be less than 2% of the average net profits of the company during the three immediately preceding financial years) as approved by the Board based on the recommendation of the CSR Committee shall be spent for one or more of the approved CSR projects or programs as mentioned in this Annual Action Plan.
- Any unspent CSR amount or excess spent CSR amount shall be dealt with as provided in subsection (5) & (6) of section 135 of the Companies Act 2013, read with the Companies (Corporate Social Responsibility) Rules, 2014 and Schedule VII to the Companies Act, 2013, as amended from time to time.
- The entire budgeted amount for the FY 2026-27 as approved by the Board based on the recommendation of the CSR Committee shall be endeavoured to spent in the financial year 2026-27 and if the Company fails to spend such amount, the Board shall, in its report made under clause (o) of sub-section (3) of section 134 of the Act, specify the reasons for not spending the amount.
- The funds will be directly disbursed to implementing agencies (in the case CSR activities/projects is implemented by them) as per mutually agreed disbursement schedule, ensuring requisite approvals.
- All CSR Initiatives will be implemented as per the mutually agreed timelines with implementing agencies.

**Monitoring and Reporting Mechanism:**

- The Board shall ensure that the funds disbursed for Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR) are utilized for the approved purposes and in the manner specified.
- The Chief Financial Officer shall certify the financial management of these funds.
- The CSR Committee shall oversee the implementation of CSR projects, programs, and activities within the approved timelines and year-wise allocations as per the CSR Policy.
- The Committee shall ensure compliance with the provisions related to CSR in the Companies Act, 2013, and the Rules made thereunder.
- The Committee is authorized to make necessary modifications for smooth project implementation within the overall permissible time period.
- The progress of CSR initiatives and activities shall be regularly reported by the CSR Committee to the Board.

**Impact Assessment;**

In accordance with the provisions of CSR Amendment Rule 2021, Impact Assessment will be conducted as per the applicability.

**Other Affirmations:**

- The above list of activities shall also include, exclude, modify such activities may be notified by the Ministry of Corporate Affairs from time to time.
- The above list is broad based/ illustrative and must be interpreted liberally so as to capture the essence.
- Any activity/projects which the proposed Trust/Implementation Agency wishes to carry out in the FY 2026-27 beyond the above list of focus areas as approved in this Annual Action Plan, the Trust/ Implementation Agency shall submit a proposal to the Company which shall be placed for the approval of the CSR Committee and the Board respectively.
- The Company may also undertake such other activities in the FY 2026-27 as it may consider appropriate with the approval of the CSR Committee and the Board.
- Provided that every implementing agency, who intends to undertake any CSR activity, shall register itself with the Central Government by filing the form CSR-1 electronically with the Registrar.
